



- Avoid clutter!



## **Editing Tricks**

- •Cropping remember the rule of thirds
- •Exposure/Levels/Brightness this depends on your program, but with all of them, you can add more light to your photo
- Blacks/Levels/Contrast again depends on program, but you are adding contrast and making your images pop
- •Saturation/Vibrance not always necessary, but makes colors richer
- •Transform your photos Lightroom, PS, etc. either manually or with Actions, Presets, Filters and Textures


