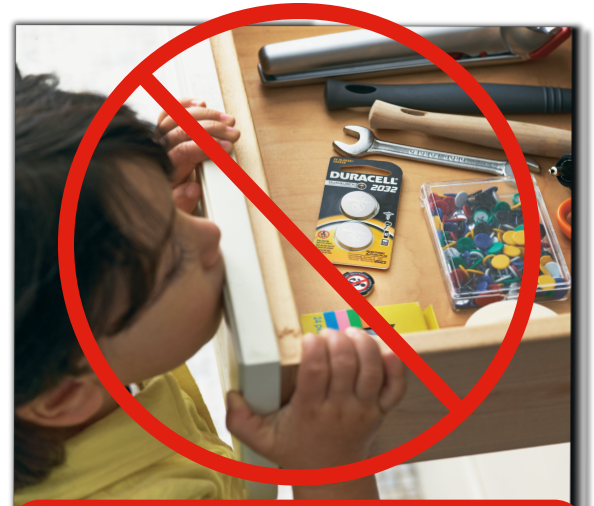


Lithium Coin Battery Safety

trash cans

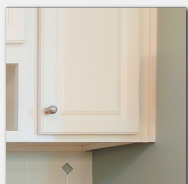
WARNING!

Keep batteries away from children. If ingested, initial symptoms may be similar to other childhood illnesses such as coughing, drooling and discomfort.

PRACTICE THESE SAFETY TIPS



Secure battery compartments with tools or tape



Store batteries out of reach of children



Wrap used battery in tape when disposing
