

## **Homemade Glass Cleaner**

*For washing windows*

Mix in a spray bottle. (A glass spray bottle works best.)

1 ½ cup water

2/3 cup vinegar

5 to 10 drops Tea Tree (*Melaleuca Alternifolia*) Essential Oil  
(Optional)

## **Citrus Multipurpose Cleaner**

*For cleaning kitchens and more*

Mix in a spray bottle. (A glass spray bottle works best.)

3 parts water

1 part vinegar

10 drops Lemon Essential Oil (or use lemon juice)

5 to 10 drops Tea Tree (*Melaleuca Alternifolia*) Essential Oil  
(Optional)

## **Homemade Furniture Polish**

*For dusting wood furniture*

Mix in a glass spray bottle.

1 cup water (distilled is best)

¼ cup vinegar

2 tsp olive oil

10 drops Lemon Essential Oil (or use lemon juice)

## Cleaning Shower Head

*An easy trick for cleaning a showerhead*

- 1 cup vinegar (approximate)
- 1 sandwich baggie
- 1 hair tie or elastic

Tie baggie full of vinegar around showerhead. Secure with elastic and leave on overnight. In the morning, remove baggie, wipe clean and then turn on shower to flush vinegar.

## Baking Soda Cleaning Tricks

**Bathtub** – Make a paste with baking soda and water to scrub bathtub.

**Kitchen Sink** – Make a paste with baking soda and water to scrub sink.

**Mattress** – Sprinkle baking soda on mattress, let sit for an hour and then vacuum.

**Toilet** – Add a cup of baking soda and a cup of vinegar to your toilet bowl. Let sit and then clean bowl with toilet brush and flush.

## Lemon Cleaning Tricks

**Faucets** – Rub half a lemon on faucet to remove soap scrub.

**Dishwasher** – Place a cup of lemon juice on the bottom rack and run the rinse cycle.

**Cutting boards** – Rub half a lemon across cutting board and let sit 20 minutes before rinsing.

**Microwave** – In a microwave safe bowl, add water, lemon juice and lemon skin. Cook for 3 to 5 minutes. Remove bowl and wipe down the inside of the microwave with a wet cloth.
